Beautiful teamwork, class!

STUDENTS

You’re like the lady in the story!

TEACHER

And you’re my Autumn bouquet! What do we say to our new student, class?

STUDENTS

Glad to have you, Autumn Leaf!

TEACHER

Recess, everyone.

PLAY TRACK. SG #6 - Windy Bye Bye

As the track plays, ALL ON STAGE exit the classroom. As the wind sound builds in the music, they all begin to be “blown away” by the wind, all exiting one after the other. The classroom scene is left intact.

REGGIE and SKY, make sure AUTUMN LEAF is safely with them as they blow away. AUTUMN LEAF’s backpack gets left behind and MAX, now happy that Autumn Leaf is in his class, runs back on stage to get it for him, fighting the “wind” all the way.

MAX

(running to catch up to his new friend, he shouts over the wind)
Autumn Leaf! Wait! You forgot your backpack! Don’t worry! I got it...

MAX is the last student to exit.

Track SG #6 transitions into a softer piece of music, then ends.

Enter SNOWY, a large snowflake, wearing a warm winter scarf as part of her costume, and FROSTY, a snowman, also wearing a warm scarf and hat as part of his costume.

Both have backpacks or lunch pails and are excited to be at school, but they “freeze” in position when they hear the children coming with their teacher. They are unsure of how they will be welcomed.

Enter TEACHER and WILL’S MOM, with a few students. These can be a different teacher and students from the first two scenes or the same teacher and students, depending on the size of your cast. Students from the past two scene’s name are used here for convenience. You can change these names as desired. TEACHER a large open box with holiday wrapping on the outside. Inside are warm winter scarves, gifts for her students. STUDENTS cannot see what is in the box. It is a surprise.

Once the class is in their places, SNOWY and FROSTY tiptoe in to a far end of the classroom and try not to look too obvious.

STUDENTS feel a sudden chill and start shivering a bit.

TEACHER

As you know, students, this is our last hour together before you go home for winter break. I have some lovely things planned for you before you go.

COLTON

Please tell me one of the things is turning up the heat.

JORDAN

Yeah, I’m freezing!

OTHER STUDENTS

We’re ALL freezing!

KAT

(noticing Snowy and Frosty, not happy)

Maybe it’s because of those two *visitors* in the back of the classroom!

TAYLOR

(shivering)

Just what we need on a cold winter’s day.

ROOK

Ah, I don't know. I'm a big fan of winter sports myself. Hi, guys!

SNOWY and FROSTY wave shyly.

PAISLEY

Oh...They look scared.

SKY

They probably think Rook is gonna make snowballs out of them.

SNOWY and FROSTY huddle together in fear.

WILL'S MOM

Nobody's making snowballs in here today. These are our two new students, Snowy and Frosty.

MAX

With names like that, no wonder we're freezing.

TEACHER

I'm sure they don't mean to make anyone uncomfortable. They're just being who they are.

SNOWY and FROSTY stop huddling. FROSTY whispers something in SNOWY'S ear. She nods. They each remove their scarves and go over to Colton and Jordan and kindly wrap their scarves around them. FROSTY puts his hat on Kat. COLTON, JORDAN and KAT are a little scared, backing away at first, but the kindness of Snowy and Frosty helps them accept the warm gifts. SNOWY and FROSTY go back to their spot.

TEACHER

That was very sweet of our newest students. What do you say, Colton? Jordan? Kat?

COLTON, JORDAN, AND KAT

Thank you.

WILL'S MOM

Snowy and Frosty are really making me look forward to Winter Break. Who in here has a Winter Wonderful they are looking forward to?

PAISLEY

Drawing on the window frost!

Sledding in the street!
JOEY

Winter Wonderlands!
RUTH

New mittens!
DRAKE

PLAY TRACK. SG #7 - Winter Wonderfals Accomp.

TEACHER
These remind me of a song my mother taught me.

SNOWY AND FROSTY
(excited)
We know this one!

SNOWY and FROSTY join in TEACHER'S song at some point. STUDENTS and WILL'S MOM join in along the way.

SONG - WINTER WONDERFULS

TREES WITH BARREN LIMBS, MITTENS ON YOUR HANDS
CHILDREN, SLEDDING IS THEIR TREAT FOR WHAT

FROSTY SNOWMEN, WINTER WINDS A BLOWIN'

SNOWY
SNOWFLAKES FALL ON THE TIP OF YOUR NOSE

ALL ON STAGE
